

## **DPO Standing Committees**

Any Democrat who resides within in the 4<sup>th</sup> Congressional District may serve on the Democratic Party of Oregon's standing committees. You can only serve on one committee at a time. Delegates to the SCC and 4<sup>th</sup> CD may vote for representation to the DPO standing committees.

### **Budget – 2 delegates/1 alternate**

Duties:

1. Prepares a two-year budget for the Democratic Party of Oregon for submission to the Executive Committee by the end of November of each general election year, and for the subsequent submission to the State Central Committee at its 4th quarter meeting;
2. Makes all necessary reports to the State Central Committee.

### **Credentials – 2 delegates/1 alternate**

Duties:

1. Signs up members of the SCC and Executive Committee, designating delegates and alternates.
2. Conducts elections for party officers with the assistance of DPO staff;
3. Assists with members' registration for special events, and other duties as assigned.

### **Platform and Resolutions Committee – 5 delegates/2 alternates**

Duties

1. Recommends resolutions to the SCC;
2. Submits a draft platform to the DPO's platform convention;
3. Assures that proposed resolutions and platforms are submitted in accordance with the Bylaws and rules of the DPO.
4. Recommends ballot measures to the SCC.

### **Rules Committee – 3 delegates/2 alternates**

Duties:

1. Reviews the Bylaws regularly and recommends amendments;
2. Proposes the rules and procedures for state conventions. Those rules and procedures are to be approved by the delegates of those conventions.
3. Reviews the bylaws of prospective special group caucuses to ensure those bylaws meet the goals and Bylaws of the DPO. The committee may recommend approval of the caucus to the SCC.

### **State Fair and Local Events Committee – 5 delegates/2 alternates**

Duties:

1. With the assistance of DPO staff, operates the State Fair booth, and assists county central committees with operating booths at their county fairs;
2. Assists county parties, congressional district parties, and caucuses at local events when asked.
3. Performs the other functions that may be assigned by the SCC.

Note: Duties of the Fourth District Standing Committees parallel the duties of the state standing committees. The members and alternates of the district standing committees shall be persons elected or appointed as members and alternates of the state standing committees representing the Fourth Congressional District.
